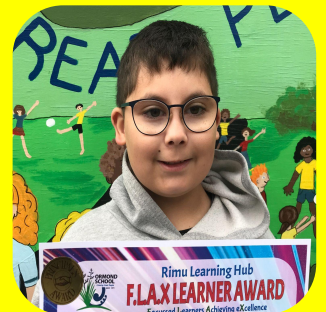
## Luchia

## Ramin

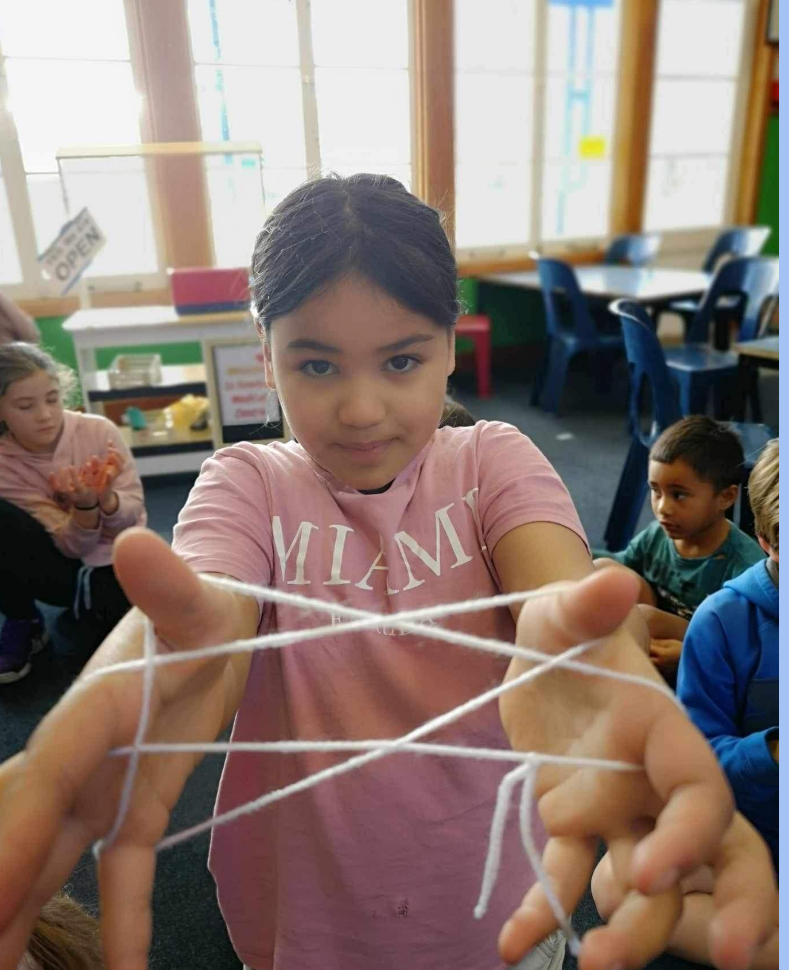
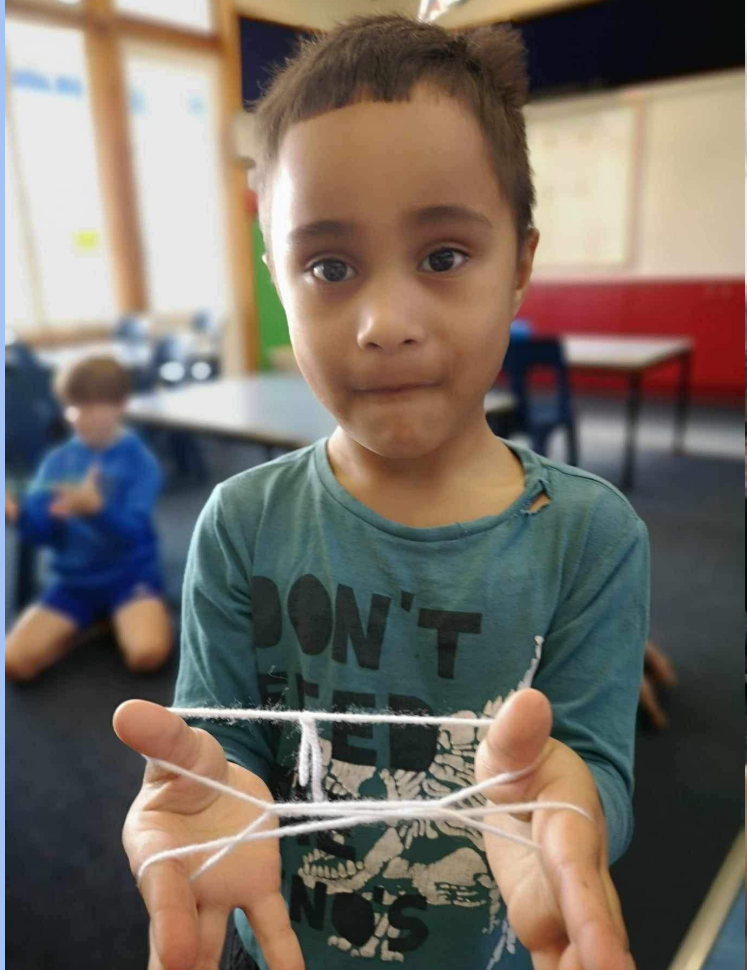
